Treatment Summaries and Survivorship **Care** Plans

Since 2005, we have been in the company of advocates who strongly believe that posttreatment cancer survivors should receive a care plan. However, it is still unclear whether care plans improve quality of life or health outcomes, or if survivors even use them once they leave active care. This year, we asked survivors to tell us whether they had received one and if it was useful to them.

WHAT IS A SURVIVORSHIP **CARE PLAN?**

For post-treatment cancer survivors, a care plan can include a treatment summary, possible future side effects or symptoms, details about when to return and whom to see for checkups, tests and information about healthy living.
